

SINUS INSTRUCTIONS

Because of very close relationship to the maxillary sinus, many times when a tooth is extracted, or a sinus lift/push is performed, it may leave a communication between the mouth and the sinus. This is the situation in your case. Therefore, it is important to follow these instructions:

- 1. Take your prescriptions as directed.
- 2. Refrain from blowing your nose for two weeks.
- 3. Try to stifle all sneezes.
- 4. Do not use a straw.
- 5. DO NOT SMOKE
- 6. No air travel for two weeks.
- 7. No submerging your head (swimming) for two weeks.
- 8. Eat soft foods for several days, chewing on the opposite side if possible.
- 9. Do not rinse the mouth too vigorously for several days.

In most cases, small mouth-sinus communications heal uneventfully and cause no problems. We will check this area carefully at your post-operative visit.
